We were able to continue offering our Virtual Exercise Academy (VEA) with the addition of yoga and cooking instruction as well as plan a new healthy relationships program in 2022-2023.

In closing, I want to say again how grateful AADD is for the financial gifts we received from foundations, businesses, and individuals like you in 2021-2022. Every gift made a difference for each of our members and their families, including the 15 scholarships that we were able to award to members who would not otherwise be able to participate in our programs. 
