Due to Covid-19 we have temporarily pivoted to virtual RAP group and trips. We have taken virtual "trips" to many locations and had fun playing games and having parties.



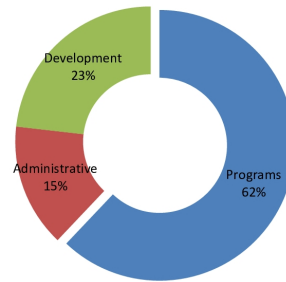
October to February we had S.A.F.E. training with Victim Services Center of Montgomery County funded by a grant from Next for Autism and the Night of Too Many Stars.

Financials

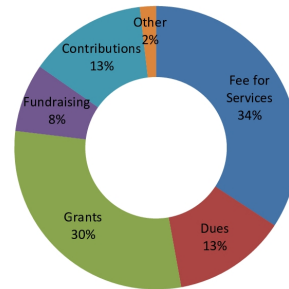
2019-2020 Revenue - \$358,304

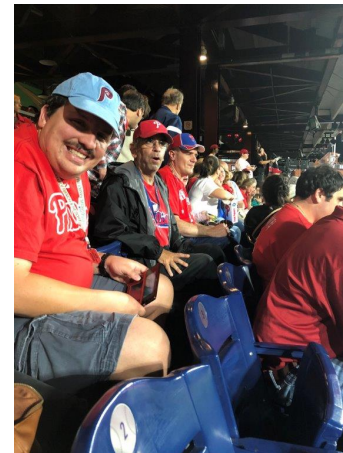
