Fall Fest @ JCHAI

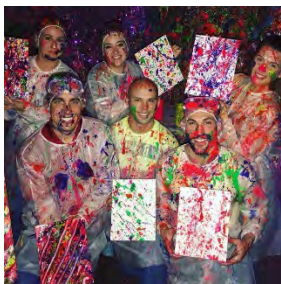
